### **The School**

Lighthouse Christian School opened in 1979 and is accredited by the Tennessee Association of Christian Schools as a Category II school. LCS is a ministry of Lighthouse Church and was founded in 1979. The school consists of a Pre-School, Elementary and Middle/ High School. LCS is primarily college preparatory institution. All incoming students are placed on a track that will allow them to receive a diploma, which meets all state requirements for entrance into four-year college systems.

### **The Students**

Student enrollment for the 2008-2009 school year is approximately 611 K2-12<sup>th</sup>. The class of 2009 consists of approximately 30 seniors, 90% are expected to enroll in a four year college, with 8% attending a two year institution; the remaining students plan to enter a technical school or the military.

### **Athletics and Extra Curricular Activities**

LCS athletics are numerous, competitive and successful. Sports opportunities for the students include baseball, basketball, cheerleading, cross country, football, golf, soccer, softball, volleyball and wrestling. ### **The Curriculum**

For the class of 2008-2009, LCS requires 24 credits accumulated in high school level courses: 4 English, 3 mathematics, 3 science, 3 social studies, 4 Bible, 1 physical education, 1 health, 1 fine art, 1 computer, 2 years of foreign language to total 24 credits. Advanced courses are offered in math, science and English. Students are required to follow a college prep course unless special permission is granted by the administration to pursue a general diploma of 22 credits. The primary curriculum publishers for LCS are A-Beka and Bob Jones. These are distinctively Christian curriculums with an educational philosophy, which supports strong thinking skills. Students meeting specific requirements are allowed to participate in dual enrollment programs offered by various universities and colleges.
